CENTER FOR PUBLIC INTEREST LAW

The Center for Public Interest Law at DePaul University College of Law was founded in 2006, the result of the efforts of a group of law students determined to see the law school formalize its commitment to public interest law. In essence, the center is the structured formalization of a very long tradition of public service at DePaul, which allows the College of Law to live the university mission of service to the poor and underrepresented.

“Our goal in creating CPIL was to provide a formal structure to the widespread commitment to public interest law by DePaul’s faculty, students and alumni. We wanted to empower students to pursue careers in public interest law through an expanded curriculum, an active network of alumni mentors, and loan forgiveness. My certificate in public interest law is more than a piece of paper to me; it is a symbol of DePaul’s ongoing support for my work in serving the public interest.”

PUBLIC INTEREST CLINICS

Under faculty supervision and guidance, students sharpen their skills and knowledge while engaging in legal practice outside the formal classroom setting. More than 50 law students participate in one of DePaul’s public interest clinics each semester:

- Asylum/Immigration
- Civil Rights
- Criminal Appeals
- Death Penalty
- Family Law
- Misdemeanors
- Technology/Intellectual Property

COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICE LEARNING

The College of Law recognizes that community service is a vital component of legal education, as it exposes students to the human side of the problems they seek to address. To that end, DePaul offers a number of opportunities designed to develop students’ understanding of lawyering as they serve. DEPAUL UNIVERSITY AND COLLEGE OF LAW FACTS

DePaul University is the eighth-largest private, nonprofit university in the nation with more than 24,000 students. RECOGNIZED FOR ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

The College of Law is currently ranked among the top 100 law schools in the country by U.S. News & World Report, and its intellectual property and health law programs rank among the best in the nation. DePaul law students take advantage of 14 research centers and institutes, eight legal clinics and 11 areas of specialization, including seven certificate programs.

CAPITALIZING ON CHICAGO CONNECTIONS

The College of Law, centered in the heart of Chicago, is surrounded by a thriving, diverse downtown environment with hundreds of public interest groups and community service and support organizations. More than 8,500 of the College of Law's 14,000 law graduates are actively practicing in the Chicago area, many of them leaders and partners at some of the most prestigious law firms.

ENROLLMENT

In fall 2009, the College of Law enrolled 1,022 students, including 746 full-time students and 276 part-time students.

STUDENT PROFILE

Of more than 5,100 applicants to the College of Law, 252 enrolled in the full-time program and 109 enrolled in the part-time program for fall 2009. Thirty-two percent of the incoming class was minority students, and 50 percent were female. More than half hailed from outside of Illinois.
