**At John Marshall Law School, Professor Liu investigates emerging patent issues in U.S. and Asia. He currently offers courses comparing US and China patent law and addressing cross-border IP enforcement. He also directs the China IP Resource Center there, which has a dual goal of training SIPO examiners and Chinese Attorneys and disseminating information about Chinese IP law here in the U.S.**

**Before entering academia, Prof. Liu represented clients in Japan, China, Taiwan and the U.S., including pharmaceutical start-ups and consumer product manufacturers. He also helped navigating companies through the Hatch-Waxman Act.**

**Prof. Liu received J.D. from University of California, Los Angeles, where he was an editor for UCLA Law Review and Pacific Basin Law Journal. He studied biochemistry and molecular biology at Harvard University and conducted drug discovery research at Sphinx Pharmaceuticals/Eli Lilly before entering law.**
