Professor Rajec's primary research interests are in the areas of patent law and international trade law. She has taught "TRIPS, Patents and Public Health" at G.W. Law's Munich IP Summer Program, and will be teaching Torts in the Fall.

Professor Rajec graduated with honors from Brown University, where she majored in physics. She earned her J.D., cum laude, from the University of Michigan Law School.
