Professor Rosenblatt joined the Whittier faculty in 2009. She teaches intellectual property subjects and directs the Center for Intellectual Property Law. Following law school, Prof. Rosenblatt practiced intellectual property litigation with Irell & Manella in Los Angeles, where she specialized in the areas of patent, trademark, copyright, and entertainment law. Following practice, she was a Fellow in Intellectual Property Law at UCLA School of Law and an Adjunct Professor of Trademark Law at USC Gould School of Law. Her scholarship has been published in the Florida Law Review, Communications and the Law, and the Harvard Journal of Law and Gender. Her most recent article, A Theory of IP's Negative Space, will be published in the Columbia Journal of Law & The Arts in Spring, 2011.
