Frank H. Easterbrook is a judge with the United States Court of Appeals for the 7th Circuit and a senior lecturer at the University of Chicago Law School. Before joining the court in 1985, he was the *Lee and Brena Freeman Professor of Law* at the University of Chicago, where he taught and wrote in antitrust, securities, corporate law, jurisprudence and criminal procedure. He has published two books and more than 50 scholarly articles in these fields. His most recent book, "The Economic Structure of Corporate Law" (with Daniel R. Fischel), was published in 1991. Judge Easterbrook also is engaged in economic and legal consulting work with Lexecon Inc. He served as co-editor of the *Journal of Law and Economics* from 1982 to 1991 and as a member of the Judicial Conference's Standing Committee on Rules of Practice and Procedure from 1991 to 1997. Before joining the University of Chicago law faculty in 1979, Judge Easterbrook was deputy solicitor general of the United States. He received his bachelor's degree from Swarthmore College and his Juris Doctor, cum laude, from the University of Chicago. He is a member of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, the American Law Institute, the Mont Perelin Society, Phi Beta Kappa and Order of the Coif.
