

## **Art and Cultural Heritage Legal Society Scholarship Application**

### **Instructions:**

**Eligibility:** This scholarship is available to one student at DePaul University College of Law who is working in a legal position within the mission of ACHLS:

The purpose of this organization is to put DePaul students in touch with the legal community, especially in those areas affecting museums, the art market, contemporary artists, and cultural heritage. The Society accomplishes this goal through mentoring, publishing a newsletter, hosting networking events at DePaul and in the greater Chicago community, and hosting practicing professionals as speakers. The Society also works closely with professional organizations to offer DePaul students the chance to learn about the evolving and diverse legal landscape of art and cultural heritage law, and strives to provide practical opportunities for students within their chosen career field.

Applications will be judged based on academic achievement, financial need, and contribution to the mission of ACHLS. Applicants must be in good academic standing to be considered. Students who do not currently have a position may still apply. However, the scholarship will not be disbursed until the student supplies a copy of an acceptance letter for a qualifying position. In the event that the scholarship recipient does not obtain a position by June 1, the scholarship will be given to the runner up.

**NOTE:** Pursuant to College of Law and ABA Policy, students may not normally receive scholarship funding if they are also receiving course credit for work done at the legal position.

**Award:** Amount to be determined based upon funds raised for the Reception.

**Application:** Complete the application form in its entirety and submit by the deadline with:

1. an expanded resume (maximum 2 pages), including (1) all previous work and volunteer experience (legal and non-legal positions); (2) special qualifications and skills; (3) certificates obtained; and (4) languages spoken, and
2. an unofficial transcript (available at Campus Connect).

**Application Deadline:** March 18, 2011 (Late submissions will not be considered.)

**Selection:** The recipient will be selected by a panel of DePaul faculty and staff. No students are involved in selecting the recipient.

### **Notification of Award:**

The winning recipient will be notified by April 1, 2011. Public announcement of the winner will be made during the ACHLS Scholarship Reception. **The recipient is expected to attend the Scholarship Reception**, to be held on April 12, 2011, from 6-8 pm. at Quartino, 626 N. State.
