WHAT IS GUIDED RESEARCH

A student who has completed at least 31 credit hours with a 2.00 or above grade point average may engage in assigned research under the direction and supervision of a full-time professor. A professor may supervise a maximum of two students per semester.

Guided research may be taken for one or two credits. Each credit represents approximately 4-6 hours of work per week. Evaluation of student work is pass/fail. The student is expected to meet regularly with the professor during the semester to receive research assignments.
