GRADING

There will be one three-hour examination in this course, which will comprise the basis of the course grade. The only material which can be brought into the exam will be the volume of Selected Statutes, Rules and Forms under the Federal Securities Laws which may not contain any writing. The examination will be graded using traditional law school standards.

In addition to the examination, class participation will be counted on a qualitative basis as an addition to grades. For example, if participation warrants an addition, the grade may be raised to the next highest level, e.g., C+ to a B or a high B to a B+.
